In Figure 5, Communities Around SSFL on page 20, the labeling for Runkle Canyon is misplaced and it should be moved closer to the Santa Susana Field Lab (SSFL). Also in Figure 5, the Community of Oak Park should be included as a fair representation of population surrounding All Sides of the SSFL. In Section 4.1.2, Chatsworth, The completion of railway tunnel no. 26 & no. 27 was in 1905, construction began in 1898. Source. http://docs.cpuc.ca.gov/published/Agenda_resolution/29344.htm In Section 4.1.4, Simi Valley, The arrival of the railroad in Simi Valley was in 1905. In Section 4.4.1, Key Community Concerns...A concern of mine that was not included, the DOE predecessor, the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) contracted North American Aviation's Atomics International (AI) Division to do research in AREA I in the AI Tower. On September 15th of 2009 the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board found Radionuclides in the watershed of this AI Tower Drainage. ETEC had operations at Vertical Test Stand 3 (VTS 3) in The Bowl of AREA I. This needs to be addressed. In Section 5.3.4, Mailing List Expansion, The DOE should share this information with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) to ensure nobody is left out of a chance for involvement. In section 6.0, Upcoming Program Activities and Involvement Opportunities, Biomonitoring should be a program to consider, as there are elevated cases of Cancer and other Health Problems that could potentially be related to the SSFL. In conclusion, Appendix C – Stakeholders, my name is misspelled and it should read Aerospace, not American.
