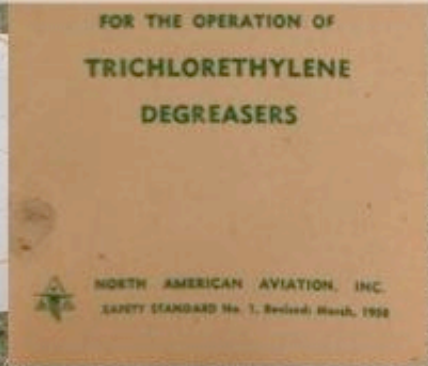
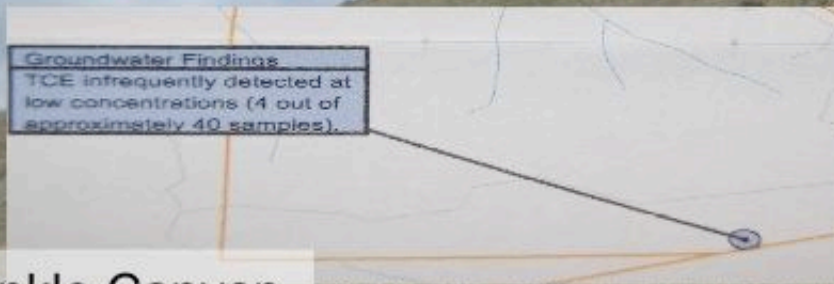


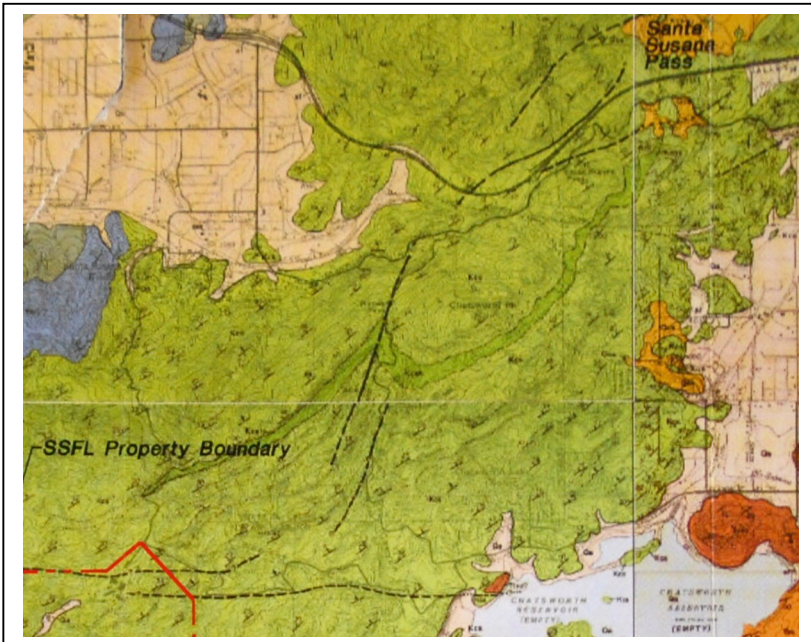
December of 2007, MWH, a contractor for the Boeing Company and NASA (Santa Susana Field Laboratory) issued an Off-Site Data Evaluation Report. In the said report there were Trichloroethylene (TCE – A known Carcinogen that produces various Cancers and Neurological Disorders) detections in a well known as OS-21 (OS=Off-site). This is also known as the “Windmill Well” at RUNKLE CANYON as there still stands a ranch/farm style windmill near it’s property border over 2000 feet above Sea Level in the City of Simi Valley.

In June of 2012 DTSC found Naphthalene & Toluene, these, like TCE, are not Natural. How did it get there?

TCE Groundwater contamination from the Sage Ranch plume appears to be moving northeast following the Shear Zone and heading towards to Chatsworth Train Tunnel that is pumping groundwater at a rate of over 4000 gallons a day discharging into Simi Valley and another 4000 plus gallons a day discharged into Chatsworth Park South. Runkle Canyon also has found some TCE and other SSFL contaminants on their property.
