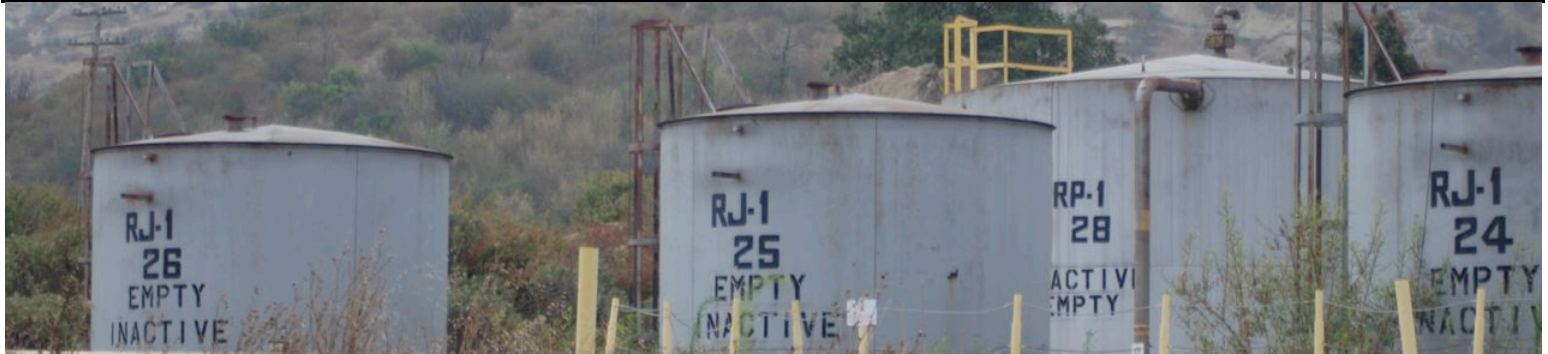

ACME (Aerospace Contamination Museum of Education) Comments - Environmental Impact Statement



Below are ACME comments on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) – Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL) – Ventura County, California.

As listed in the Federal Register, the above stated document calls for “Environmental Cleanup Alternatives” which is in violation of the December 2010 Administrative Order of Consent (AOC) with the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) signed by NASA that calls for no other alternative but to clean the SSFL to Background. This needs to be reflected in the final document as we look forward to a proper cleanup of the NASA portion of the site.

This site is the headwaters to the Los Angeles River (LAR) and to offer cleanup alternatives less than what is already in place could have negative impacts on these waterways that are being developed for public use.
