William Preston Bowling Proposes Legislation to Help Men and Women who Served Our Country

Topanga Canyon California – On September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2006, before Microsoft put \$240 Million Dollars into Facebook and in the same year Twitter was created, William Preston Bowling attached what Social Media was available to a much needed Nuclear and Chemical Cleanup. His creation led a network of discussion and information sharing regarding the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL) and it's related facilities. Today, with Over 200 Members, including Legislators, Former Nuclear Workers and many of the Responsible Parties themselves; The Rocketdyne Information Society has delivered Over 5400 Posts of much needed information on a topic that is as difficult to understand, as it is intriguing.

ACME will now be known as the <u>Aerospace Contamination Museum of Education</u> with a mission to <u>Ensure a Proper CleanUp of the Santa Susana Field Laboratory, it's Related Facilities and their Surrounding Communities</u>...Soliciting members to form an Advisory Board, Aerospace Contamination Museum of Education founder William Preston Bowling feels that "Providing factual information in a neutral manner, rather than push an alarmist agenda, is what the Surrounding Communities have needed for decades" Bowling will open a physical museum that will focus on current cleanup initiatives, public participation groups and provide historical information as seen in his previous creation <u>www.RocketdyneArchives.com</u>

Many Rocketdyne employees are Veterans who served our Country, including John Pace, the only known survivor of the 1959 SSFL Sodium Reactor Partial-Fuel Meltdown. William Preston Bowling has started a petition to Propose Legislation that will assist Veterans and their families. Bowling, the 2009 President of the Malibu Association of REALTORS, currently Chair of their Legislative Committee, will go on to serve as 2011 Regional Chair of the California Association of REALTORS. His proposal... Purchase Agreement offers from Veterans participating in VA Loan Programs will take priority over any non-owner occupied offer, if the VA offer is equal to, or greater than the investor's offer, on all California Bank-Owned properties... This will contribute to an increased neighborhood value, and help to reduce crime, as the pride of ownership from Veterans will outweigh the investors purchase, as those typically sit vacant during remodeling. A documentary film crew will be following Bowling during this process as he meets with local and state legislators.
