With the oversight of the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (LARWQCB) and the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), and with guidance from the Surface Water Expert Panel, The Boeing Company and NASA have been implementing the Interim Source Removal Action (ISRA) and new stormwater quality management practices within their portions of the NPDES outfall 008 and 009 watersheds at the Santa Susana Field Laboratory.
