From West Side

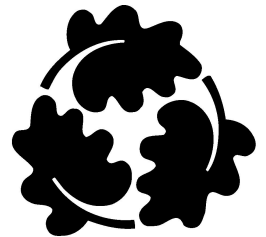
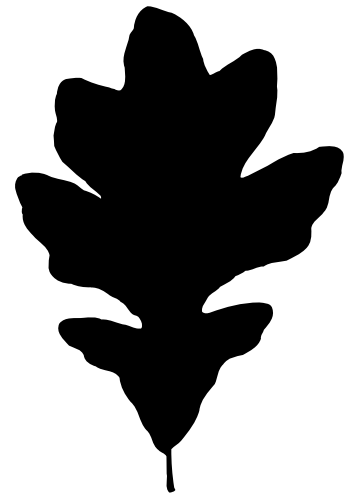
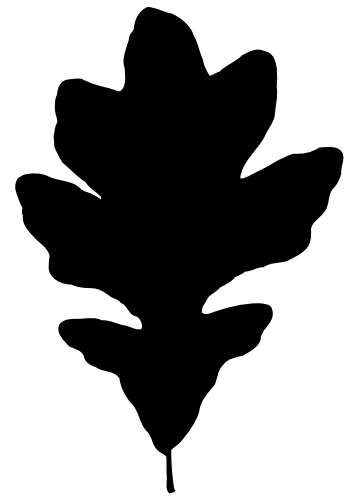
Take the 405 North toward Sacramento. From the 405 take CA-118 West toward Simi Valley. Take Topanga Canyon Blvd., exit 34. Turn left on Topanga Canyon Blvd. Approx. 2 miles, turn right on Plummer St. Turn a slight Left onto Valley Circle Blvd. The park will be on your right. Look for the TreePeople signs.

From the Valley

Take 101 North toward Ventura. Take Topanga Canyon Blvd., CA 27 N exit. Turn Right on Topanga Canyon Blvd. Travel approx. 5 miles, turn left on Plummer St. Turn a slight Left onto Valley Circle Blvd. The park will be on your right. Look for the TreePeople signs.
