Pursuant to your request in a letter dated February 11, 2010, The Boeing Company (Boeing) submits the revised *Standard Operating Procedures: Building Demolition Debris Characterization and Management, Santa Susana Field Laboratory, Ventura County, California*, dated February 24, 2010. (SOP). The revised SOP documents Boeing's existing procedures for preparing a Boeing building/structure for demolition and characterizing building materials for either recycling or disposal. Additionally, it addresses the DTSC comments expressed in the February 11, 2010 letter and during several conversations between DTSC and Boeing staff during the past two weeks. Based on this level of involvement from both DTSC and Boeing, we are confident this procedure is acceptable to DTSC.

We understand DTSC intends a 30 day comment period to provide the community an opportunity to review and comment on the SOP before DTSC's final review and approval. During the public review period, Boeing will prepare demolition work packages for submittal to DTSC in early April with the ultimate goal of resuming demolition work in May. Therefore, Boeing respectfully requests DTSC's final review and approval of the document one week following the public comment period (April 9).

Boeing appreciates DTSC's continued involvement and interest in the demolition activities at the Santa Susana site. We look forward to future DTSC site visits to observe our progress. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me at (818) 466-8795.
