Project Update

Santa Susana Field Laboratory Look-up Table Development

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) held the first in a series of discussions with the community regarding the development of the look-up table for radionuclides on October 20, 2011. During this meeting, we discussed the process, timeline, and factors that will be considered for the look-up table development.

Currently, the US EPA is in the process of validating data related to the radiological background study. As soon as this process is complete, we plan to share this information with the community. Due to the time required to thoroughly complete this process, DTSC has decided not to hold a technical roundtable discussion in November 2011.

DTSC anticipates hosting a Technical Roundtable meeting in December 2011 to continue our discussion with community stakeholders on the look-up table for radionuclides. We will send an announcement to the community as soon as this meeting is scheduled.
